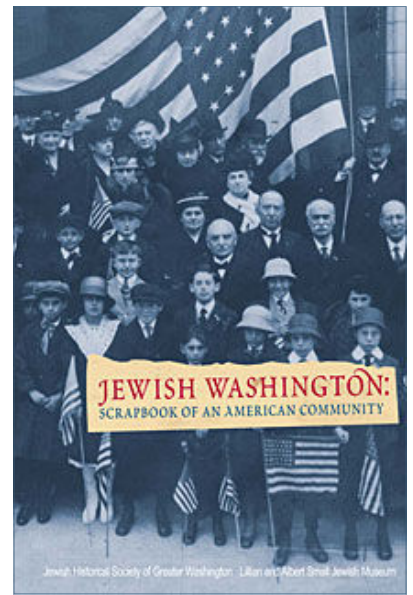


JEWISH WASHINGTON: SCRAPBOOK OF AN AMERICAN COMMUNITY
